A special emphasis will be put on regulation and competition policy (vertical and horizontal consolidation, access pricing, tie-ins, interchange fees,...) but related topics are also welcome.

The primary focus is on academic research, but we intend to organize one or two panel sessions to confront the views of industry experts and regulators, for instance on antitrust issues.
